Company Description

Bionomics (ASX: BNO, OTCQX: BNOEF), is a global, clinical stage biopharmaceutical company leveraging its proprietary ion channel platform technologies to discover and develop a deep pipeline of best and first in class novel drug candidates focused on the treatment of serious ion-channel mediated central nervous system disorders.

Pipeline and Developments

Bionomics' lead drug candidate BNC210, a novel, proprietary negative allosteric modulator of the alpha-7 nicotinic acetylcholine receptor, met both primary endpoints from its Phase 2 trial in generalized anxiety disorder (GAD) and is currently in Phase 2 for the treatment of post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD). Data from the PTSD trial is anticipated in Q3, 2018.

Bionomics has a strategic partnership with Merck and Co., Inc (known as MSD outside the US and Canada) and MSD is a 4.5% shareholder. In February 2017 MSD triggered a US\$10 million milestone payment with the entry into clinical development of a therapeutic candidate for the treatment of Alzheimer's Disease. In 2014 Bionomics and MSD entered into a research collaboration and licensing agreement in the area of cognition in which Bionomics may receive up to US\$506 million in upfront, research and milestone payments in addition to royalties on sales of licensed products.

What we are looking for:

Bionomics is seeking to out-license clinical stage oncology assets BNC101 (Phase 1) and BNC105 (Phase 2) in order to focus its development efforts on BNC210 and other ion channel targeting therapeutic candidates.
