

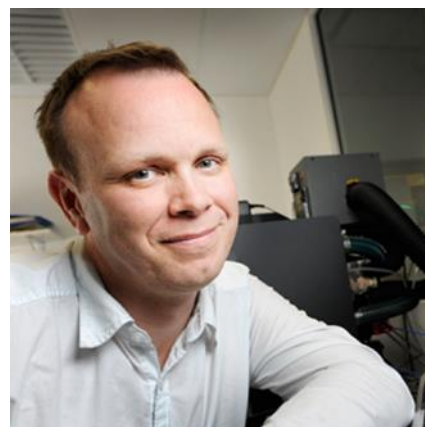


SPEAKER PROFILE

Associate Professor Derek Richard CARP Pharmaceuticals

Associate Professor Derek Richard is the Chenhall Research Scientist at Queensland University of Technologies Faculty of Health. He is also Scientific Director of the Cancer and Ageing Research Program, Director of Translational Imaging Queensland, Chair of the Cancer and Ageing Research Foundation sits on the advisory panel at CARP Pharmaceuticals.

Derek obtained his PhD in microbial biochemistry from The University of Dundee (Scotland). After his PhD, he worked as a Fellow at the University of St Andrews, before moving his research in 2004 to the Queensland Institute of Medical Research, in Brisbane Australia. In 2011 moved his research team to the Institute of Health and Biomedical Innovation (IHBI) at Queensland University of Technology. He has published in prestigious journals including *Nature*, *Immunity*, *Genes and Development*, *Molecular Cell*, *Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences*, *Journal of Cell Biology*, *Pathology*, and *Nucleic Acids Research*. He has received over \$19m in competitive research funding in the past 5 years and his research led to the development of DKLS02. Derek sits on the advisory panel of CARP Pharmaceuticals.
